1: Boat Owners are expected to carry liability insurance as a minimum at the Petpeswick Yacht Club. The club or memberships as a whole is not responsible for any damages to vessels, equipment or personnel while using our facilities under this agreement.

2: Renters are expected to ensure their slip is kept neat and tidy and do not store equipment garbage etc, unless approved by the Rear Commodore.

3: Slips must not be modified in any way without the approval of the Rear Commodore.

4: Slips changes/re-leasing, (short term or long term) must all be approved by the Wharf Committee. (Rear Commodore).

- Boaters who wish to rent or lease their spaces may do so provided it does not put the club or other boaters at risk. To this end, if such a deal is made, it must first be approved by the Wharf Committee (Rear Commodore).

5: The black flotation dock on the Southwest corner of the Main Wharf is reserved for the Learn to Sail Program. This cannot be used during weekdays by boaters unless permission is received from the Learn to Sail Director. Weekend use may be possible if approved by the Rear Commodore.

6: The Yacht Club reserves the right to expel a boater from a slip or mooring if complaints are raised and founded. Boaters are expected to promote safe and responsible boating and uphold the image of the club.
